

Each year, the Cape Cod Viewfinders Camera Club enters the Greater Lynn International Competition as a club entry. Accepted images will be shown on April 10th at Danvers High School as part of an afternoon seminar with a teaching program on judging first at 1 pm.

In 2010, thirty-one members of the Cape Cod Viewfinders entered a club entry. Susan Mosser, exhibition chairperson reported that counting the top seven top scores, CCVF ranked 3rd out of 24 clubs with a total of 343 points. In first place was Stony Brook Camera club with 353 pts and in second place was Merrimac Valley with 344 pts. Amanda Reed won a Greater Lynn Honor Award for her image “Wood Duck Flapping”, Bill Low won a Greater Lynn Honor Award for his image “Back Stroke” and Peter Selig won a Greater Lynn Honor Award for his image “Watchful Snow Leopard”.
