Quite a few images were disqualified by the judges.

- Pay attention to human elements in the background. They may be insignificant to you but judges have eagle eyes and can pick up the smallest out-of-whack detail.
- Be careful about putting in domestic animals. In one case the domestic animal causing the DQ was brought to the attention of the club during the entry process and was not replaced even after a second notice.
- Be careful about putting in hybrid plants. Plants can be tricky and you rely on the knowledge of the judges. A lot of plants can start out as human derived hybrids and become "garden escapes". Others do not escape. When in doubt, don't rely on the judge giving you the benefit of the doubt. Go to the many available guide books and double check the suitability.
- Black and White images are allowed in nature but unlike monochrome categories in Pictorial Prints, EID and CPID, the image is only allowed to be black and white. Restoring an original color is not allowed.

Since this was the last contest of the year, the F/67 judges also selected the Class A and Class B Images of the Year from the 15 images in each class that won Awards of Merit.

- The Class A Image of the Year is "The Charge" by Phil Echo of the Camera Naturalists Camera Club of New Jersey.



- The Class B Image of the Year is "Lake Huron Sunrise" by Bill Niessen of the London Camera Club of London, Ontario, Canada



IMPORTANT: We need three clubs to step up and judge our contests for the 2010-2011 Season. The three dates would be:

- Between November 7 and November 22 for a Contest #1 entry closing date of October 22, 2010
- Between February 1 and February 15 for a Contest #2 entry closing date of January 15, 2011
- Between May 1 and May 15 for a Contest #3 entry closing date of April 15, 2011

The dates for Contest #1 are a week later than usual because of a conflict with the PSA International Conference in Charleston. I will not be getting home until around October 16.

The actual date within the range above is up to the host club. A reminder that the host club does not get a makeup. No more than one of the three judges on the panel can be from the host club. Please let me know if you are willing to host a contest and which one(s) you would prefer to host.
